Synopsis

§ 87(2)(b) filed her complaint with the IAB on October 30 2006, via telephone. The CCRB received the complaint on November 2, 2006 via IAB log number 06-36668. § 87(2)(b)'s son, § 87(2)(b) relayed this complaint to her. § 87(2)(b) was in police custody at the time of § 87(2)(b)'s complaint. § 87(2)(b) did not witness the incident. The CCRB spoke to § 87(2)(b) on November 13, 2006, and he gave a more detailed account of the incident.

During the early hours of October 28, 2006, § 87(2)(b) had gotten into a fight with his girlfriend, § 87(2)(b) at her house in the Bronx. § 87(2)(b) ran out of the house half-naked and into a gentleman's car. § 87(2)(b) ran to this man's car and punched one of its windows to get her out. A police car a block behind the incident stopped at the scene. PO Maurice Harrington and PO Joel Medina, identified by name, got out of the vehicle. One of the officers yelled to § 87(2)(b) to get on the ground. As he lay on the ground, PO Harrington kicked § 87(2)(b) in the face and his body roughly three times. § 87(2)(b) received bruises and bumps on his body from the attack, as well as a dislocated jaw. § 87(2)(b) was then dragged 10-12 feet to a police vehicle. PO Harrington dragged § 87(2)(b) by the back of his arms, and PO Medina dragged him by his feet.

In addition to the CCRB calling § 87(2)(b) five times and sending him two letters, he missed his scheduled November 21, 2006 interview. § 87(2)(b) had scheduled the interview on November 13, 2006, the only time in which the CCRB was able to speak to him. On November 27, 2006, the CCRB called § 87(2)(b) and left him a message stating that if he did not call the CCRB by the morning of December 1, 2006, the case would be truncated. § 87(2)(b), § 87(2)(g)
