PO Harrington proceeded to the front desk and after speaking with he went to the back for a time and then returned, asking for his license and registration. Told PO Harrington that he did not have the documents with him. PO Harrington responded that he could not do anything about it then. To Harrington responded that he could not do anything replied, "Well I need help," to which PO Harrington responded, "oh well, that is not my fucking problem" (Allegation A).
