Initial Complaint Narrative

[REDACTED] came out of a party in his home and was leaving to go to his girlfriend's house around 4:30am. There was a huge dispute in the hallway of the building and [REDACTED] went back in the building to check on his mother, to make sure she was not being hurt. When the police arrived, they saw [REDACTED] arguing with the guys who started the fight. Upon arriving the police started swinging and pushing people to the floor. The police pushed [REDACTED] to ground, pepper sprayed him and pushed his girlfriend, [REDACTED] to the floor. The officers also pushed [REDACTED] s mother, [REDACTED] to the floor. Officers continually "beat" [REDACTED]. There is a camera in front of [REDACTED] that may have recorded the incident. [REDACTED] identified the following officers who were involved in the incident: Lieutenant Joyce Williams, who pushed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to the floor, was described as a Black female who is 5' 6" tall with shoulder length black hair. PO Merlyn Brito, was described as a Hispanic female who is 5' 7" tall, with dark hair and a caramel complexion. PO Jason Cruz, who [REDACTED] indicated was the arresting officer, was described as a Hispanic male who is 5' 4" tall with a stocky build and short black hair.

[REDACTED] also filed a complaint regarding this incident via the call processing system [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that there was a fight, but following the officers' arrival, the officers did not want to hear what [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] had to say. Officers chased [REDACTED] pushed him to the floor, punched and kicked him. [REDACTED] was pepper sprayed and dragged on the floor. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] s mother, [REDACTED] were also pushed to the ground. [REDACTED] was hit on the head. [REDACTED] cousin, [REDACTED] was in a vehicle that was stopped at an unknown location on [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was hit on the head by officers. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were arrested and charged with gang assault. At the 46th Precinct stationhouse, the officers would not give [REDACTED] who is diabetic, food or water. The officers also did not provide him with medical attention. (It was not clear if he requested any.) [REDACTED] stated that there were multiple uniformed officers from the 46th Precinct in marked vehicles, but she did not know the names of any of the officers. [REDACTED] sustained a bruised foot. [REDACTED] sustained bruises, impaired vision, and she does not have feeling in one of her fingers. [REDACTED] sustained head injuries, impaired vision and a fractured foot. Later in the call, [REDACTED] stated that it was a fractured knee. [REDACTED] sustained bruises. However, to date, they have not obtained medical treatment.
