## Initial Complaint Narrative

---

The following narrative was obtained from a message [REDACTED] left on a call processing system on April 14, 2018: On April 14, 2018, at approximately 4:30PM, southbound on the FDR in Manhattan, an officer thumbed [REDACTED] on the chest for refusing to get off his motorcycle. The female sergeant intentionally dropped [REDACTED]'s motorcycle to the ground causing damages. [REDACTED] was issued multiple summonses and the motorcycle was confiscated. [REDACTED] Nurke has been experiencing chest pain. Five officers: \*PO1= Sgt., female. \*2 white male officers. \*2 African American male officers.

-----On a callback with Intake, [REDACTED] provided the following narrative: On April 14, 2018, at approximately 4:30PM, by East 124th Street southbound on the FDR in Manhattan, [REDACTED] was pulled over. An officer placed his hands on [REDACTED]'s chest and slightly pushed [REDACTED] back causing him to almost fall off the motorcycle. While [REDACTED] was waiting for the summons the officers reenacted how [REDACTED] almost fell and the officers laughed. [REDACTED] told the officers that they were very unprofessional and that karma is a hell of a thing and that they will get theirs. The officers then threatened to seize his motorcycle and arrest him. [REDACTED] asked for what as all his paperwork is good. [REDACTED] told them to go ahead and arrest him. The female sergeant held [REDACTED]'s motorcycle and asked him to get off of it. When [REDACTED] got off of his motorcycle the sergeant dropped the motorcycle to ground causing damage to the plastic. [REDACTED]'s motorcycle was impounded. [REDACTED] received four summonses, one for § 87(2)(b), one for § 87(2)(b), one for § 87(2)(b), and one for § 87(2)(b). PO1- Female, Sergeant, in uniform 2 White males 2 Black males
