

Detectives Vasquez, Brown, and Toribio gave chase after As they came in close proximity of a scuffle ensued, which subsequently resulted in a forcible takedown and being placed in handcuffs. alleged that the detectives used excessive force, causing him to sustain a headache. He was taken \$87(2) , treated, and released with Motrin for the headache. Detectives Mede and Jaquez chased after as he ran into the lobby of \$87(2)(b) and attempted to run up a flight of stairs.
