Initial Complaint Narrative

On June 17, 2020, § 87(2)(b) filed the following complaint with the Attorney General's Office, which was then sent to the IAB Command Center. The original log number #2020-15387 was forwarded to the Office of the Chief of Department (OCD). The following was referred to the CCRB via log number #2020-15475 and it was received on June 29, 2020. On June 17, 2020, the IAB Command Center received an email from the Attorney General's Office that included several complaints with multiple allegations pertaining to the George Floyd protests that occurred on different dates and incident locations. This complaint was filed specifically for an incident that occurred at an unspecified time on May 30, 2020 in front of the § 87(2)(b) in Manhattan

§ 87(2)(b) was covering the events that were taking place around the city along with two other photojournalists when they noticed a group of civilians passing by § 87(2)(b) and they vandalized a police vehicle that was parked in front of it. As the group was leaving the incident location and heading uptown, one of them returned and they threw "something" that was on fire into the police vehicle. § 87(2)(b) and the other photojournalists remained at the incident location to document the scene. At some point, an officer who was assigned to SRG exited the hospital with his firearm drawn and he pointed at § 87(2)(b). The officer instructed § 87(2)(b) to back the "fuck" away from the police vehicle, but no one was near the police vehicle at the time, including § 87(2)(b). § 87(2)(b) filed his complaint because he believed the officer was a "rogue" cop.- SRG
